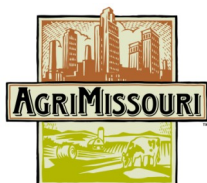
Competition Rules

- 1) Displays must be made up of locally grown fruits, vegetables, herbs or flowers originating from growers who are members of the market entered in the competition.
- 2) Entrants must supply their own 10 ft x 10 ft canopy.
- 3) Displays must be contained within and under the 10 x 10 ft supplied canopy and not exceed the overall measurements of 9 (nine) ft wide, 5 (five) ft deep and 8 (eight) ft high.
- 4) All display entries must be assembled and ready for viewing at the Santa Fe Trail Food & Wine Festival by 11:00 am and remain displayed until 5:30 pm. Judging will take place between 11:30 am and 1:30 pm. Winners will be announced between 1:30 and 2:30 pm.
- 5) Entries will be judged on creativity, use of local produce, aesthetically pleasing design and attractive promotion of local foods.
- 6) First, second and third prizes will be awarded and the judges decision will remain final.
